
Chantry chapels

The aisles and transepts were occupied by chantry chapels or chancels where masses were said or sung for their founders. Open screenwork of stone or wood enclosed each chapel and inside tapers and incense glowed beneath richly ornamented canopies. There were eleven chancels in the Nave.
