As before, they will introduce their programme during the concert, as much of their material is either traditional, self-composed, or on occasion improvised. The artists make a point of having a good dialogue with the audience and talk through the programme as they play.

The artists:

Dominic O'Sullivan, Aidan Hammond, and Rob Roberts bring together the joy of whirling session tunes, introspective original works, and a combined wealth of influences from across the traditional, classical, and contemporary spheres.

As O'Sullivan, Hammond, and Roberts they make music inspired by stories and places from their lives both shared and separate and the tunes that have been written and collected along the way. The trio blur the line between improvisation and arrangement and re-imagine what folk music means as they explore their own small corner of the living tradition.

Born of their shared training at the Royal Birmingham Conservatoire and coloured by their years touring with orchestral folk powerhouse **Juniper**, this more intimate project balances subtlety with flair to entertain and spread the delight of a good tune played among friends.
